A VERY SHORT HISTORY OF GOLDFIELD
In December 1902, two prospectors, Harry Stimler and Billy Marsh found Gold north of Goldfield, Nevada. In 1903 building of the town began. During 1903 and 1904, mines were producing as much as \$10,000 per day. 1905 saw a building boon and the addition of the Tonopah & Goldfield RR. 1906 saw a population explosion past the 15,000 mark and the addition of more than 150 new building in a single month's time and the Gans-Nelson fight. 1907 saw more buildings and a miners strike in which Federal Troops were called in to restore order. The town and did well until about 1910 but soon labor problems, and a combination of human and natural disasters caused the towns fortunes to deteriorate. A flash flood washed out part of the town on September 13, 1913. Ten years later, a fire destroyed more than 50 square blocks of homes and businesses leaving only the Courthouse, the High School, the Fire House, the Goldfield Hotel, and a few commercial and residential buildings. With few prospects, and little energy to rebuild, the boom was over and Goldfield quietly settled down to await rebirth.
